Re: New State Recycling Requirements for Businesses and Recycling Questionnaire

Starting July 1, 2012, the State of California has enacted new legislation, AB 341, a Mandatory Commercial Recycling provision affecting businesses and multi-family communities. This letter is to inform you and your business of the requirements of the new regulation and to assist you with compliance.

Who Must Recycle:

California State law requires the following businesses to arrange for recycling services, effective July 1, 2012:

- Any business that generates 4 cubic yards or more of waste per week
- Multi-family communities with five or more units

Questionnaire:

The State of California is requiring the City of Riverbank to contact businesses and multi-family complexes about the Mandatory Recycling Requirements and how to recycle in Riverbank.

Please fill out and return the attached one-page questionnaire, and let us know if and how you are recycling. If you need any assistance in setting up your recycling program, please let us know.
