### **CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION PROGRAM FOR JANUARY 2018**



Gilton Solid Waste Management will be doing curbside collection of Christmas trees after the holidays. Tree collection will be during the first two FULL weeks in January: *STARTING* on Tuesday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>; and *ENDING* on Friday, January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

Guidelines for tree collection:

- Trees will be collected on customer's scheduled GARBAGE collection day
- Trees need to be in front of the house (even if normal service is in the alley)
- Trees need to have all metal stands, lights, and ornaments removed (wooden stands left on the tree are okay)
- Trees should be placed on the street surface next to the curb with a minimum of 6 feet away from cars or waste cans
- If trees are treated with flocking, paint, or fireproofing, it is preferred that they be cut up and put into refuse can, however this is not absolutely required.

## 2018 STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULE

The City of Riverbank is contracted with Gilton Solid Waste Management for the sweeping of City streets. Residential streets and the Downtown business area are swept twice a month, on a recurring schedule.

Beginning in January 2018, the residential area of Crossroads is changing from a Thursday sweeping schedule - to the new street sweeping day of Wednesday. **Sweeping is now on the ODD numbered WEDNESDAYS of each month in the Crossroads area.**

Below is the updated Street Sweeping Map provided by Gilton Solid Waste Management showing all of the City of Riverbank street sweeping zones; the weekday of street sweeping; and when the sweeping occurs -- on an odd or even numbered day of the month.

Just a reminder, the City of Riverbank is still following the **OUTDOOR WATER USE POLICY - WINTER SCHEDULE** which allows for **2 days of watering per week** and is in effect through March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018:

**EVEN-NUMBERED ADDRESSES:**

Tuesdays & Saturdays;  
before 10:00 a.m. and after 4:00 p.m.

**ODD-NUMBERED ADDRESSES:**

Wednesdays & Sundays;  
before 10:00 a.m. and after 4:00 p.m.

- No landscape irrigation (watering) between the hours of 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Landscape irrigation is prohibited at all times on Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays.
- Landscape irrigation is prohibited within 48-hours after a measureable rainfall event, regardless of the aforementioned permitted Winter Watering Schedule.
- Drip or Micro-spray irrigation systems are exempt from the above restrictions.
