CHANGE IN WATERING SCHEDULE



Mark your calendars for the upcoming **Watering Schedule** change. On March 31, 2018, the **Winter Schedule** ends.

On April 1, 2018 the **Summer Schedule** begins and will remain in effect until October 31, 2018. This transition brings an extra day of watering for a total of **3 watering days per week** as follows:

EVEN-NUMBERED ADDRESSES:

Tuesdays, Thursdays & Saturdays;
before 10:00 a.m. and after 7:00 p.m.

ODD-NUMBERED ADDRESSES:

Wednesdays, Fridays & Sundays;
before 10:00 a.m. and after 7:00 p.m.

Spring can still bring showers so keep in mind landscape irrigation is prohibited within 48-hours after a measureable rainfall **regardless** of the aforementioned permitted Summer Watering Schedule.

CANNABIS UPDATE

With spring just around the corner, people are starting to think about their flower, vegetable, and even cannabis gardens. While flower and vegetable gardens are enjoyable outdoor activities, outdoor cannabis gardens are prohibited. Growing cannabis indoors in a

locked room keeps the plants away from children and pets but also deters the theft of these valuable plants. The City approved an Administrative Cannabis Permit ("ACP") process last year for ensuring the safety of those who wish to begin gardening indoors.

On September 22, 2017, Riverbank City Council Ordinance No. 2017-007 became effective, permitting the cultivation of up to six (6) cannabis plants per residence indoors. The ordinance bans all cannabis activities outdoors, both personal and commercial. The indoor designation includes sheds and greenhouses as well as the residence. If there is a three (3) car garage on the property, only one bay may be converted to a cultivation site. The cannabis is for personal use only and cannot be sold. No Home Occupation Permits will be issued.

The process for obtaining a required Administrative Cannabis Permit ("ACP") is simple. It requires a one (1) page application, a proposed floor or site plan (may be hand drawn), and an application fee. The review is at staff level and includes one (1) inspection by the Building Inspector, who will be looking at health and safety items such as locking doors, adequate ventilation, and electrical work. If approved, the permit lasts for one (1) year and may be renewed. For more information visit our website at www.riverbank.org or call 209.863.7128 or 209.863.7124. Stanislaus County is holding its **Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event** in Riverbank on Friday, April 20 and Saturday, April 21 from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon at the City's Corporation Yard located at 2901 High Street. This is a **FREE** disposal opportunity for Stanislaus County residents.

ACCEPTABLE Household Items:

- Used Oil/Oil Filters
- Antifreeze
- Gasoline/Diesel Fuel

- Carburetor Cleaner
- Paint/Paint Thinner
- Aerosol Products
- Batteries (all kinds)
- Pool/Spa Chemicals
- Charcoal Lighter Fluid
- Mercury Thermometers/Thermostats
- Road Flares
- Pesticides
- Herbicides
- Roof Tar
- Kerosene
- Fertilizers
- Car Batteries
- Brake Fluid
- Drain Cleaners



UNACCEPTABLE Household Items:

- No Empty Containers
- No Tires
- No Business Waste
- No Out-of-County Waste
- No Commercial AG Chemicals
- No Asbestos
- No Hard Concrete
- No Radioactive Waste
- No Welding Equipment
- No Explosives
- No Ammunition
- No Dried Paint Containers
- No Propane Cylinders larger than 5 gal.
- No Cooking Oil
- No Pharmaceutical Waste

Note: No electronics or light bulbs will be accepted at this mobile collection event. In addition, Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources limits waste loads to 15 gallons or 125 pounds.

BE SAFE With Your Waste:

- Label all materials
- Do not mix materials
- Keep all waste in original containers with lids on tight
- If a container leaks, place it into a sturdy plastic bag or bucket, and label
- Transport waste in the rear of your truck or trunk of your car
- Do not leave your car with waste sitting in the sun or leave packed overnight.
