- A Certificate of Liability Insurance listing the City of Riverbank as additionally insured is required for all FOOD vendors.
 - FOOD vendors must submit a Stanislaus County Temporary Food Facility Permit.
 - Electricity is not provided. Vendors requiring power must supply their own quiet generator.
 - Vendors must provide their own canopy, tables, chairs, lighting, and weights.
- Setup: Vendors may begin setup at 6:00 AM on Saturday, October 10th
Friday setup (October 9th) may be available upon request, please contact the event coordinator.
